Memo Clarification

This memo clarifies the information provided in OLIN 2020-04 Online Vehicle Sales and Off-Site Delivery, which added social distancing and post drive test sanitation requirements to existing dealer online vehicle sales and off-site deliveries during the COVID-19 outbreak period.

The purpose of OLIN 2020-04 was to clarify requirements during the outbreak period. The COVID-19 outbreak requirements listed below will **only** end when the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) declare the close of the outbreak.

The COVID-19 outbreak requirements are:

- All state and local social distancing requirements must be adhered to at the time the vehicle is delivered.
- Adherence to social distancing requirements and sanitization of the vehicle is required if a test drive of the vehicle occurs.

All other requirements relating to online vehicle sales and off-site delivery pre-dated the COVID-19 outbreak and remain in effect beyond the close of the outbreak.
