2024 Miscellaneous Fee Increases

New Information

Effective January 1, 2024, two Occupational Licensing-related fees will increase. These fees will affect occupational licensees with identification (ID) license plates such as dealers, manufacturers, dismantlers, distributors, remanufacturers, and vehicle transporters.

Procedures

Programming will be in place to calculate the following fee increases:

Several fees authorized by the *Vehicle Code* are subject to an annual adjustment based upon the Consumer Price Index.
