

Unobtainable Title Cert/Salvage Cert Process

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Issue Date: March 28, 2023

New Information

Effective January 1, 2023, legislation changed the Unobtainable Title Certification for Issuance of Salvage Certificate/Nonrepairable Certificate process. The applicant must complete an attestation of the attempts made to obtain the Certificate of Title or other evidence of title.

The new attestation is included on the revised Unobtainable Title Certification for Issuance of Salvage Certificate/Nonrepairable Certificate (REG 492, REV. 12/2022) form. Evidence of the two written attempts to obtain the Certificate of Title or other evidence of title is no longer required. Only one REG 492 is required per vehicle if there is a Registered Owner and Legal Owner.

Procedures

Salvage/Nonrepairable Certificate applications with unobtainable titles submitted on or after April 1, 2023, **must** include the revised REG 492 (REV. 12/2022) form. This includes Report of Deposit of Fees (RDF) applications initially received prior to that date and returned on or after April 1, 2023.

On all DMV forms, including the REG 492, the signature for a company/business **must** include the printed name of the company/business and an authorized representative's countersignature on the signature line (for example, ACME INSURANCE CO. by *John Smith*, agent -or- *John Smith*, agent for ACME INSURANCE CO.)

Background
