New Information

Changes to the Department of Motor Vehicles Virtual Clerk system (utilized by Business Partner Automation [BPA] Program participants) were implemented to verify the registered owner address, including zip code, county code, and allocated county code. To improve data quality for impacted transactions, the Virtual Clerk system will verify the registered owner address updated to the vehicle record and smog status.

Procedures

Continue to follow existing procedures in the *Vehicle Industry Registration Procedures Manual*, Chapters 1 and 10. If the below error message is displayed in Virtual Clerk, BPA Program participants should contact their First Line Service Provider for guidance:

0331 ALLOCATED COUNTY CODE MUST NOT EQUAL COUNTY CODE

Background

The BPA Program allows participants to process vehicle registration-related transactions at their own locations/offices and issue license plates and stickers. Changes were implemented to verify compliance and ensure vehicles registered in the biennial and partial biennial smog counties are subject to smog requirements.
