Effective: January 1, 2026

New Information

The Statewide Ignition Interlock Device (IID) Pilot Program has been extended through December 31, 2032.

Procedures

Continue checking the driver's eligibility for an IID installation or removal. IID installers **must** complete and fax the Ignition Interlock Device (IID) Installation and Removal Request (DL 925) form to the Driver Licensing Mandatory Actions Unit (DLMAU) at (916) 657-9042 (this fax line is for IID installers only) or call the IID installer's dedicated telephone number.

Background

Senate Bill (SB) 1046 (Hill, Ch. 783, Stats. 2016) established a Statewide IID Pilot Program which began on January 1, 2019, and was due to sunset on December 31, 2025. Assembly Bill (AB) 366 (Petrie-Norris, Ch. 689, Stats. 2025) was signed into law on October 27, 2025, and extends the IID Pilot Program from December 31, 2025, to December 31, 2032.
