## **New Information**

Effective January 1, 2026, occupational licensees are prohibited from using internet domain names that include the initials “DMV” or the words “Department of Motor Vehicles.” This change is in accordance with Assembly Bill 1272 (Dixon, Ch. 68, Stats. 2025), which expands existing law prohibiting the use of the initials “DMV,” the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) logo, or the words “Department of Motor Vehicles” in any business name or telephone number.

**NOTE:** A violation of *Vehicle Code* §25 is punishable as a misdemeanor.

## **Background**

DMV is notifying the automotive industry of new laws that took effect starting January 1, 2026.
