

New Motor Vehicle Board Fee Increase Notice

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Effective: April 1, 2026

New Information

The New Motor Vehicle Board (NMVB) will increase its annual fee from \$300 to \$425. This fee applies to all new retail dealers and to every applicant seeking or renewing a license as a new motor vehicle dealer or dealer branch.
