Notice of Modification of Proposed Regulations

Section 158.50. Lien Sales - Value of Vehicle Determined by the Department.

In accordance with Government Code section 11346.8(c) and Section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, the Department of Motor Vehicles (department) provides this notice for the purpose of inviting comments regarding modification of the proposed regulations related to Lien Sales.
