

Notice of Modification of Proposed Regulations

Title 13, Division 1, Chapter 1

Article 2.1- Commercial Driver Licenses

In accordance with Government Code section 11346.8(c), the Department of Motor Vehicles (department) provides this notice for the purpose of inviting comments regarding modification of the proposed regulations governing medical certificates for commercial drivers. The regulatory language as originally proposed was published in the California Regulatory Notice Register on April 5, 2024, and provided to interested persons for comment. The department received no comments on the originally proposed text and submitted the proposed rule to the Office of Administrative Law for review. The OAL determined that additional amendments are necessary to ensure the regulations are clear.

Attached is the full text of the proposed regulation as well as an Addendum to the Initial Statement of Reasons that provides the necessity for the modifications. The text includes the originally proposed language as well as the proposed changes to the language. The language modifications are clearly illustrated by the following methods:

- (1) The language originally proposed to be added to the text is single underlined.
- (2) ~~The language originally proposed to be removed has a single strikethrough.~~
- (3) ~~The language now proposed to be deleted which was originally proposed to be added is double overstruck and single underlined.~~
- (4) The language now proposed to be added to the text is double underlined.
