

**NOTICE OF MODIFICATIONS TO TEXT OF PROPOSED REGULATIONS  
AND ADDITION OF DOCUMENTS TO RULEMAKING FILE**

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code section 11346.8(c), and section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, the Department of Motor Vehicles is providing notice of changes made to proposed regulations originally noticed to the public in the California Regulatory Notice Register on April 25, 2025, related to Autonomous Vehicles.

All written comments received by **December 18, 2025**, which pertain to the indicated changes or the above-listed documents and other information, will be reviewed and any objections and/or recommendations responded to by the department's staff in the Final Statement of Reasons as part of the compilation of the rulemaking file.

- (1) The language originally proposed to be added to the text is single underlined.

(4) The language now proposed to be repealed is shown with ~~double~~  
~~strike~~through.
