

Notice of Proposed Emergency Action

August 21, 2026

The Department of Motor Vehicles (department) proposes to adopt Sections 26.04 and 26.06 in Article 2.1, related to English Language Proficiency Assessments for Commercial Drivers.

Government Code section 11346(a)(2) requires that at least five working days prior to submission of the proposed emergency action to the Office of Administrative Law, the adopting agency provide a Notice of the Proposed Emergency Action to every person who has filed a request for notice of regulatory action with the agency.

After submission of the proposed emergency to the OAL, the OAL shall allow interested persons five calendar days to submit comments on the proposed emergency as set forth in Government Code section 11349.6.

The department will provide notice on August 21, 2026 and accept comments from **August 24, 2026 through August 28, 2026**.

Any interested person may present comments, in writing, on the Finding of Emergency or on the proposed regulations. Written comments must be received at the OAL within five days after the department submits the emergency regulations to the OAL for review.
