## Title 13, Division 1, Chapter 1

## Article 6 – Administration

§ 423.00. Fee Adjustment.

(a) Vehicle Code sections 1678, 1685, and 9250.6 and Revenue and Taxation Code section 11052 require the department, every January 1, to adjust specified fees by increasing each fee in an amount equal to the increase in the California Consumer Price Index for the prior year. The department will adjust the fees each year in accordance with the California Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers All Items (CPI-U), as calculated by the Department of Finance with amounts equal to or greater than fifty cents (\$0.50) rounded to the next highest whole dollar. The department, following the release of the California Governor's Proposed Budget, will utilize the California CPI-U for December of the current year as forecasted and published on the Department of Finance website located at https://dof.ca.gov/forecasting/economics/economic-forecasts-u-s-and-california/ to calculate whether a fee increase is required.
