Upon the owner's death, disabled person and disabled veteran plates must be surrendered to DMV within 60 days or by the registration expiration date, whichever occurs first per *California Vehicle Code* §5007(e).

DISABLED PERSON OR DISABLED VETERAN LICENSE PLATES

PARKING PRIVILEGES

You MAY park in:

- · Designated "disabled" parking spaces.
- · Metered zones without payment.
- · Green zones without restrictions to time limits.
- Streets where preferential parking privileges are given to residents and merchants.

You MAY NOT park in:

- · Red zones.
- · Tow away zones.
- · White or Yellow (loading) zones.
- Crosshatch marked spaces next to designated "disabled" parking spaces.

NOTE: Private parking facilities may have their own rules. Please follow rules posted at private facilities.

ILLEGAL PARKING

Violations are a misdemeanor and are subject to fines up to \$3,500 and/or imprisonment up to 6 months in the county jail per *California Vehicle Code* §4461(d).

FUEL PURCHASE

(Business & Professions Code §13660)

State law requires service stations to refuel a disabled person's vehicle at self-service pumps, at self-service rates, except self-service facilities with only one employee.
